







Summer has arrived and both Clubhouse kitchens are in full swing with fresh local produce, ripe fruits and flavorful summer vegetables, inspiring us to be especially creative with our menus and specials. As the soft shell crab season begins to slow down, local wild striped bass will be fished off our coast in early July until the quota is reached, which is typically in August. Local striped bass arrives to us pristine, making this a favorite summer special. Our swordfish comes to us from the cold waters of Block Island, feeding on herring, mackerel and bluefish, making for a fatty full flavored steak.

Our new summer menu at the Downtown Clubhouse features East Coast Halibut - smashed fava bean puree, roasted tomato vinaigrette and Grilled Pork Tenderloin - watermelon salad, aged balsamic. And as always, our Downtown Clubhouse dishes are

paired with spectacular views of the city and waterfront.

We have several events for foodies coming up at the Back Bay Clubhouse, including on July 14, \$1 Oysters and Prosecco at the ClubPub. For the Summer Olympics’ Opening Night Ceremony on August 5, we’ll be featuring Brazilian themed appetizers and cocktails. 6. Click Upload
7. Click Save

**But to be eligible to win the overnight stay, we also need you to update your member interests. This will help us send you fewer emails, since we will only send things we know interest you.**

To update your interests, follow these steps:

1. Click on Member Interests in the left side navigation, under Member Profile
2. If you don't have any interests listed, click on the Edit button in the upper right hand corner
3. Check the Interests box at the top left
4. Select all of your interests from the list
5. Click Save

During the Rio Olympic Games, come hear Professor Nagy, world-renowned authority in the field of Homeric and related Greek studies, speak on the origins of the Olympics and the modern Olympic movement. Professor

Nagy is the Francis Jones Professor of Classical Greek Literature and Professor of Comparative Literature; Curator of the Milman Parry Collection of Oral Literature; and Director of Harvard University's Center for Hellenic Studies. He has chaired Harvard's Classics Department and presided over the American Philological Association.

Professor Nagy has mesmerized generations of Harvard students and alumni and has lectured widely in North American and Europe on a

wide range of topics, specifically concentrated in Homeric and Archaic Greek questions. His numerous honors include a Guggenheim Fellowship and the Goodwin Award of Merit of the American Philological Association for his book, *The Best of the Achaeans* (1979). In addition to this path-breaking work, he has published numerous works, including but not limited to *Greek Mythology and Poetics* (1990), *Poetry as Performance: Homer and Beyond* (1996), *Homeric Questions* (1996), *Plato's Rhapsody and Homer's Music* (2002), *Homeric Responses* (2004), and *Homer's Text and Language* (2004); he has also edited or co-edited various volumes and written almost a hundred articles and reviews.

At Harvard, Professor Nagy has helped pioneer the use of technology in teaching (he created Harvard edX's course on the literature and heroes of ancient Greece using works of Homer, Sophocles, Plato and others) and the teaching and use of student writing in the core curriculum.


